- The Land Use Reform Working Group has submitted 20 recommendations to County Council. We must defend our natural resources and our quality of life against those who simply want to make a quick profit.
- County Council has started early on its work to draft the 2028 Comprehensive Plan and Future Land Use Map. We plan to help shape those decisions.
- Only through focused efforts can we protect our environment and ensure that the service infrastructure—roads, schools, medical and emergency services—is adequate to accommodate growth.
